
WE ARE ONE WITH THE UNIVERSE



A long sleeping dream of mine awoke this winter and with it came some wonderful lessons. I grew up in Georgia with a deep love of the mountains - I learned their seasons and smells, their songs and the feel of her solid, soft surfaces. The Ocean was a one dimensional image in books and television, no smells or songs connected it to my I was 18 when I places of knowing. first met the ocean and though I was awed by the presence of it, there was no one to teach me her ways and I became afraid of her stinging jellyfish, strong currents and unseen creatures swirling under the surface, (not to mention the way it wrecked my hair! I was 18 remember?)

Years later I would be certified in scuba diving and fall in love with the beauty of the coral reefs, but I never became totally comfortable in this water-world.

The mountains remained my place of solace and trips to the ocean became rare....then I began to hear the call of the Manatee. Not the clear, joyful call

of the Dolphin that so many others hear, but the deep, slow"song" of the Manatee reaching out to me in dreams and pictures. The idea of being in the water with something so HUGE was intimidating to me, even though they must be the most gentle creatures on the planet. I listen less these days to the voices that say "You can't do that", so I began making plans to visit Florida friends who also love the Manatees.

Sliding out of the boat into the clear, shallow water of the lagoon still found me feeling awkward and "out of my element", the buoyancy of the wet-suit and getting used to fins, mask and snorkel ... a crowd of 6-8 excited adults and children floated in a circle around two sleeping manatees, even as they slowly rose to the surface for air every so often.

Somehow, there was one magical moment, I was floating face down about five to six feet away when the biggest one began to surface for air. I knew one gentle kick of my fins might bring me in contact with the mighty creature and instead I moved back, not out of fear this time but out of respect. 
The next day found us visiting one of my friends favorite orchards; grapefruit, tangelos, and oranges hanging in profusion from the vibrantly green trees. It is a small orchard, tended by the same man for the last 30 years and on the verge of being "transformed" into a housing development like so much of the Florida coast around it. A handsome black and white cat came to greet us, there were bushel baskets with bags of fruit marked with their price, a can to put money in and a "Gone to Lunch" sign. We chose red grapefruit and I waked over to admire a 7-8ft. tall cactus growing next to an orange tree. The sandy soil seems so thin to produce fruit in such abundance! I gave away grapefruit along my way home, and it was a week or so after my return that I received my last (?) gift from the trip. As I cut open the last grapefruit I was transported back to the orchard, remembering the feel of the soil beneath my feet, the warmth of the sun on the cats black coat as I stroked it, the beauty of the orchard, and a deep sense of connection to the land that grew my breakfast. There was a very different quality of gratitude that I felt for this food. My BODY remembered the vibration of the land and responded to it. I'm usually the first one to "lift an eyebrow" at such a statement, so I am especially grateful for the gift of experiencing it so directly. I keep hearing people say what a difficult winter this has been. For me, each test, even the most difficult ones, have brought an awareness of the "Grace" that is ever present.


the moon and the colors in the air have drawn me like a magnet to manifest the time and the resources I need so I may absorb these magnificent wonders more often.

There are three basic ways a person can live their life. One is to accept life in a resigned way and simply go along with whatever life presents. In both of these ways, no real learning is going on in relation to the life. The third way is the Spiritual way, in which, through resolute choice, commitment and conviction, you process life as nutritious food., this is done through the study and application of universal principles. This is truly living life, rather than being a slave in relation to your life.

The first step spiritually is to value and apply yourself to establishing a new thinking process which is based on universal principles. This thinking process involves Thai application of universal principles to day-to-day life, changing the viewpoint from which life is experienced. Joy is the experience of working to totally surrender to the universal principals real and permanently in our lives. The experience of this process is joy.

The practice of joy is making the entire process from the Soul and not from ego. When joy has been allowed to encompass the life, there is no attachment to anything except the Soul. This experience is not an emotional swing into any extreme. Joy appears to be a by product of right efforts. In the truest meaning, however, joy is a way of life that embraces eternity into every breath. It transforms every moment into a choice for eternity through deliberate or principled nonattached efforts. This experience and way of life is joyful. There is a story to illustrate this point. A great being, a messenger directly from God came down to the earth one day to "see" which beings were truly ready to join God. First, the great being came upon a yogi in meditation in the open forest. This yogi was intuitive and had wisdom. He "saw" the great being and prayed that the being stop there by his side to answer just one question for him: "How many more lifetimes do I have before I realize God and Merge?" The great being communicated that the yogi had two or three more lifetimes. The vogi began to sob and cry bitterly. and the great being moved on. Then the great being came upon another yogi who was gently singing and dancing under a large banyan tree. The joyful presence within the yogi also caught "sight" of this great being and then asked: "How many more lifetimes do I have, Oh Great Being, before God has filled and encompassed me?" The great being communicated: "For as many lifetimes as there are leaves on this banyan tree." The yogi, receiving this, began to weep for joy

that he would be within God at some time. This joyful gratitude is the essence of the practice of the principle of joy.

Our role as spiritual practitioners is to live under the banyan tree of infinite effort through joyful service. Doing this is the most powerful message any being can give in their ministering.

My role as a minister is in working with psychology within the medium of spiritual knowledge. By doing this, I become part of many different groups which are working toward peace in the world today. Essenes believed the Angels were the emissaries of God and therefore, performing these communions with the angels brought them in total harmony with Gods' infinite universe and nature itself, whom they called the Earthly Mother.

They believed in three paths leading to truth:

Consciousness (spirit): This path was followed by Mystics. They felt consciousness is not space, therefore, cannot be measured in spatial terms. It has its own time, which is timelessness, so truth cannot be "measured" by this path so to speak. The danger from this path however, can lead to "Exaggeration." (That this is the only path) Don't create a reality removed from the universe, loosing contact with reality and life.

Nature (Earth): Opposite of Consciousness. This is the path of the Scientist. Learning through experience and experimenting. (This can fall into exaggeration if not balanced.) This path can be explored by solitude in nature, or a vision quest. Experiencing the power of Mother Earth, the elements. All masters withdraw into nature for knowledge. Moses, Buddha, Jesus, etc.

Wisdom (Mind): This path is through culture. Knowledge acquired by great thinkers, literature through ancient means, masterpieces and man's culture and history.
