UBU'ers have been at it again! We have had some recent graduates who have received their Master's of Divinity degrees: Revs. Amari Magdalena and Steven Handwerker. Amari's focus was on ways to develop practical implementations of Shamanic principles into daily urban life for the express purpose of creating a more peaceful, loving, harmonious existence. She has done this through developing courses that teach earth-based spirituality utilizing and synthesizing her personal study of Shamanism and creating a true Aquarian model for today's life challenges. Amari is continuing her UBU program with a two-fold Doctoral Degree: a book on modern Shamanic ceremonies "We Dance To A Whispered Voice" and the initialization of The Institute for Shamanic Synthesis.

Steven's focus was to provide a program of learning for the practice of spiritual psychology in relation to developing a culture of peace. He is looking to the members of UBM for ministers in the Florida area who are interested in establishing a working group on "Spirituality and World Peace." Steven is furthering his Master's project now by going for his Doctoral Degree along the same lines. He wants to create a Spiritual psychology Program through the publication of a Spiritual Guide Book, through publications in journals, newspapers, etc. and by offering psychotherapy through doctors for patients in need, offering Reiki Healing, and a world peace working group through the American Psychology Association.

Within the UBU Board of Regents, Kathie Lumberg, Colin Tipping and Laura Pennington have all started work on their Master's degrees. Three new submissions for Master's programs include: Lucia Maison working to create the development and practice of a Holistic Living Concept for Shamanistic Evolution (offering a correspondence course; Cher Patrice Steward illustrating her continu-



ing Spiritual Trek through a Sacred Mandala format; and Dyana Hesse teaching others how to be aware of the way we flow from one path to another by divine spiritual guidance through the use of her own life metaphor.

It is our hope that these programs will give you more of an idea of what continuing your education (read that - "your life") can be like. We are all excited about these people who are stretching themselves and accelerating their own growth through these projects.



A RESPONSE TO MOTHER THERESA'S

CONCERN FOR THE CHILDREN OF THE WORLD

Mother Theresa is a Nobel Peace Prize Laureate and is the founder of the Missionaries of Charity who now have missions all over the world. On February 3, 1994, Mother Theresa gave an address to the National Prayer Association. This is an excerpt from that address:

"We must bring the child back to the center of our care and concern. This is the only way that our world can survive because our children are the only hope for the future. As older people are called to God, only their children can take their place."

When we look deeply into the spirit, we see in the eyes of all our children the true heart of the world. In their hands is the future of what we value most. Therefore, it is logical and reasonable to question what or who shall we protect?! What is our most valuable resource? And by what means shall we teach the world to help themselves? Only values that transcend apparent differences of viewpoint, perception or belief can lead the way to See both the spirit, and into the eyes of our children.

When we consider the significance of our own well-being; when we consider the significance of our fundamental resources, both material and nonmaterial, we must consider a dimension that encompasses a deep respect and love for the children of the world.



SYMBOLS By Rev. Joy Moore Sebastian, FL



Signs, symbols and pictograms (from cave drawings to hieroglyphics) are forms of communication which ask that the intuitive side of the brain be used in interpreting them. These basic forms of language require the use of our imagination, based on our experience, to receive an understanding of an event or condition communicated by their characteristics. Their magic lies in the fact that they are not wholly logical. Because they are not clear, they leave many spaces or gaps to wonder of their mystery.

Another fascinating characteristic of symbols is that the same symbol can mean something different to each person who interprets it. A tornado might mean a disaster to one person and a sign of cleansing to another. The symbol communicates to each viewer what that viewer needs to receive.

When, as a Textile Designer, I began hand painting fabrics, I discovered a desire to communicate through form and color rather than choosing realistic subjects that can be identified with the logical mind. A simple brushstroke of color can convey a strong emotion. A particular geometric shape can tell an entire story. The blank space tells as much as the form. I wanted to communicate the most possible with a simplest design and appropriate color.

After a six and a half year hiatus from painting fabrics due to space limitations, I was recently able to set up a new art studio in my home. After getting back into the swing of production again, I received a great gift, much to my surprise. As I was beginning to sketch and idea for fabric, I let my intuition guide my hand to see if I might come up with a new design or technique. As my hand began to draw, I sketched what I now call a "symbol drawing." Now that I am channeling "symbol drawings" for clients, I see how my approach to painting fabric has evolved into a conciseness needed for working with symbols.

A "symbol drawing" is a personal activation visual aid. If it is placed where it can be viewed with a few seconds of intent two or three times a day, it will send vibrations and unconscious messages to assist in healing or uplifting part of one's self that needs attention, which includes physical, mental, spiritual and emotional bodies. Each symbol drawing is completely unique visually vibrationally. Even if the same symbol appears as part of two different drawings, its message can have a different meaning for the person receiving it. Symbol drawings can be made of one or many elements. Some will reveal themselves to their owner slowly over time. Others become clear quite quickly and can even tell a fairly clear picture story. Some have said that my drawings have a Southwestern look to the, and some do. Others have their own unique style.

Animal figures are often incorporated into the symbol drawing and are a reminder that the animal world represents the symbolic also. If one notices seeing more spiders than usual or a rabbit appears in the yard, these events are not accidental.

Becoming aware of all types of signs, symbols and pictograms in our lives, whether modern or ancient, can help expand the intuitive awareness that allows one to be guided, informed of a current condition or pre-warned of an upcoming event. Symbol drawings are used as a clarifying aid, a boost to the next level of growth or a healing agent, just for starters. Begin to tune in to the symbols around you and see how they were "accidentally" put there for our growth.



HUGS

To me, hugging comes naturally. My hugs are unconditional and indiscriminate. I have hugged men and women, children and senior citizens. Some of my most rewarding hugs have been shared with the elderly. Hugs have been shared with persons of different ethnic and racial origins, different lifestyles, and different political and religious beliefs.

I have hugged ministers, judges, police officers, clerks in stores, waitresses in restaurants, and attendants in campgrounds. Hugs have been shared with persons newly introduced, and, with complete strangers. Hugs have been given to animals, who are often quite responsive, and to trees in the forest. If you have never hugged a tree, try it some time. On occasion, I even wrap my arms around and hug myself.

Hugs have been given in celebration, and, offered in consolation - sometimes just a silent way of showing that someone cares. Embraces are given in both greeting and farewell, and, have been shared in love of parents, love of children and grandchildren, and love of lovers.

Hugs are commonly a physical process. However, in the absence of proximity, hugs can be verbal, visual, mental, spiritual, or can even be in writing. Even in the new electronic communication phenomenon of e-mail there has developed a form of expressing hugs - {{{}}. The more characters sent, the bigger the hug expressed.

Occasionally, one may encounter those who are resistant or adverse to hugging. The origin of their resistance may be a personal defense mechanism of some sort, may be psychological, or may be some form of a "macho" thing. Whatever the reason, if recognized, I try to respect their space. At the same time, however, one should pray that they may somehow open their lives to more caring, warmth, and happiness.

Hugs can transcend political, religious, and social beliefs. Genuine hugs - not just symbolic ones - could help to foster peace among those in conflict. Hugs are therapeutic, healthy, and they cost nothing but time.

Hugs have the capacity for bringing so much warmth and happiness to our lives. I go forth each day with unconditional hugs to offer. In the words of our Lord - Go and do thou likewise.

That lifts me to higher ground.


I'd rather not have to take the steps Oft needed to move through pain. I'd rather just take a quantum leap And make things right again.

CLINICAL DEPOSSESSION THEORY

PART I: POSSESSION, 9/10ths of the Problem

One of the greatest blessings in life is to be able to perform a vital and uncommon service of love to humankind. This is the very definition of ministry, and I have been very fortunate to find one of the most effective therapeutic tools available to the Light 'Worker. This tool is called Spirit Releasement Therapy or Clinical Depossession Therapy.

This unique and effective therapy helps free people who are the victims of possession and entity attachment, as well as, releasing the possessing entities and returning them to the Light.

I was first introduced to the concept of clinical depossession at the 1993 Unlimited Human Symposium sponsored by the International Association of Counselors and Therapists. Don't get me wrong, I'd been a believer in the power of the demonic for many years. I began my career as an additions counselor working at a street detox on the north side of Chicago. At that time, the area I worked in was reminiscent of just about every popular notion of Hell. Over my decade of involvement with street addicts. I had many encounters that led me to conclude that the phenomenon of spirit possession was a cold, hard fact of human existence.

What I hadn't been aware of prior to 1983 was that there was a specific methodology designed to diagnose and treat the problem of spirit possession. My initiation into the world of clinical depossession was a post conference workshop in the procedure taught by Dr. Irene Hickman, D.O.

Now, those of you who are hypnotherapists are probably well acquainted with Dr. Hickman's work. For those of you who aren't, Dr. Hickman is a pioneer in the field of non-directive hypnotherapy, hypnotic regression therapy and past-life regression. She became aware of the phenomena of spirit possession through the

work of Edith Fiore (see her book, The Unquiet Dead) and William Baldwin (see his book, Spirit Releasement Therapy).

Dr. Hickman's training was as good as it gets for a one day workshop. She lectured on the reality of "earthbound" entities, who were once human and died but for some reason didn't enter the Light and became attached to a living human being. She talked about "dark entities," nonhuman intelligences who create "gloom and doom" (to quote one of them) for humans. She talked about some of the symptoms of entity attachment: anti-social or uncharacteristic behavior; extreme negativity; deep depression and psychosomatic ailments; multiple personalities; alcoholism and drug addiction. She then taught as her technique of choice that she refers to as "remote clinical depossession" because the technique doesn't require the presence of the afflicted person to be effective.

The remote clinical depossession procedure requires two people: the therapist and an intermediary sometimes referred to as a "scanner." The therapist induces a deep state of hypnosis in the scanner using his/her method of choice. Then the scanner is given the name and address of the person who is suspected of being possessed. The scanner then sends her consciousness to the person and requests permission from the person's Higher Self to "scan" the person's aura to detect any sign of possession by entities. Attached entities usually appear as dark blotches on a person's auric field generally corresponding to various parts of the body.


The therapist then addresses the blotches, telling them to speak through the scanner without harming her in any way. Through questioning (sometimes intensive), the therapist is able to establish whether or not the entity is earthbound. The entity is ushered into the light whether s/he is in the dark. The entity is encouraged with the

help of the 'forces of St. Michael" to become a being of Light and join with those who have been redeemed and restored to the Light. Many dark entities are unruly and resistant to returning to the Light. These present a challenge and require training and experience to order to deal with them effectively.

If this scenario sounds fantastic to you, I sympathize. All I can say is, after you've experienced this technique and have verified the information obtained through this technique, virtually everyone becomes a believer. More importantly, an overwhelming majority of the time, people inexplicably get well.

Like most UB Ministers, I have one primary goal which is the basis for all my other goals. That goal is spiritual unfoldment through becoming a vehicle for God/Divine Love/Spirit and serving all of life.

This deceptively simple And easy-to-use technique has done more than any other tool I've found to open my consciousness to love, freedom, inner guidance and peace of mind.



The gift is the HU. Pronounced "hue," it is an ancient word for God, a spirituallycharged word, which, when chanted or sung with love, raises the consciousness and opens the heart. A mantra similar to OHM, HU can be chanted silently or out loud,, in meditation, before going to sleep, or whenever a person wants to get in touch with their Higher Self or Soul. I sing HU to myself constantly, especially in stressful situations or when I feel the need for protection. HU is a great rush hour traffic modifier to calm stress and lower blood pressure. I know many healers who chant HU to themselves as they're giving therapeutic massage, Reiki, Chiropractic, dental or other treatments. It's particularly effective when used with the healing arts as it brings in a healing flow that gives the patient what s/he needs, while protecting the practitioner from the patient's karma.

HU is always sung or chanted like this:

- 1. Fill your heart with love
- 2. Take a deep breath
- 3. Sing H-U-U-U-U-U, using the whole breath you've taken

HU is a powerful tool for protection during meditation:

- 1. Fill your heart with love
- Close your eyes and place your attention on your 3rd Eye
- 3. Chant H-U-U-U-U-U-U aloud or silently for 5-15 minutes
- Be alert to sounds, colors, lights, images, feelings

I learned HU during my spiritual studies as a member of Eckankar, the religion of Light and Sound of God. Although it is an important part of that spiritual path, the HU is for everyone to use. It will help you make the most of your current faith, or help you recognize the path that is right for you. If you want to, try using the HU for a month and see how it changes your life as it has mine!

"Life is about learning to balance: balancing the female and male; balancing humans and animals (Ruth loved animals); the balance of light and love with all the rest of things going on in your life."



HEALTH BILL ALERT

Rev. Michael S. Jasionis (Washington D.C.) wants UBers to be aware of a rider on the Health Insurance Bill: This Awareness indicates there is that which may be termed good news and bad news, depending on how you look at things.

This Awareness indicates that there was recently passed through the House and Senate what is termed a "Health Insurance Bill." The Health Insurance Bill passage was hailed as a great victory, but it contained what is termed a 'rider'; a small amount of information that was passed quietly, without fanfare, without much attention, that undid everything entities worked for several years ago when they voted through a Bill giving permission for the masses to have and use vitamins and herbs as alternative health products without the FDA interfering. This Awareness indicates that this rider was not an FDA program, but from the World Health Organization Codex program, which is a program that regulates the medical rights, in this case preventing the use of herbs, and vitamins as food supplements, and making it so that when it takes effect, entities will need to have prescriptions even to use vitamins, such as Vitamin C, and herbs for their health needs.

This Awareness indicates it has effectively gone through the process and will have its adverse effect on the alternative health approach which has been growing with great speed and acceptance by the American society. This Awareness indicates that this is indeed bad news for the alternative health business. It can and will likely cause the eventual closure of health food stores across the country. This has already occurred in Norway, whereas over half the health food stores have closed after this law was passed in Norway.
