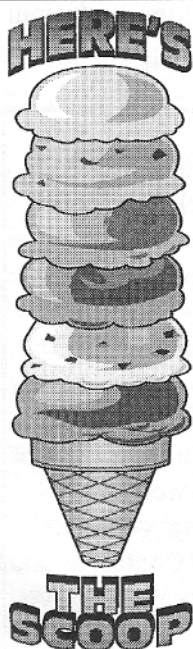

# What do You Mean "Keep the Faith"?

Have you ever felt deserted by the Creator? Ever felt deserted by your guides and teachers? Had one of those "HUMAN" moments lately? Could it be that this life is a grand opportunity to test our faith? What does the military call it? Building Character? For those of us who have little faith, it may be an opportunity to learn what faith is, perhaps for the first time! For those of us with lots of faith, yes I'm talking to those of you with more experience; it may be a matter of seeing how strong yours is. Don't worry, we won't be asking you to handle poisonous snakes, jump off a cliff, or even learn more about the remote controls on your home appliances!

A definition would be a good start: Faith: the belief in something for which there is little or no tangible evidence. For my analytical brain, a very scary proposition. The rabbi turned away from all of their answers and told them, "When you look into the face of every man and woman and see there, the face of your brother and sister, then there is light. All else is darkness."

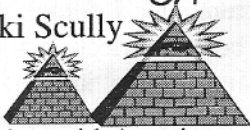

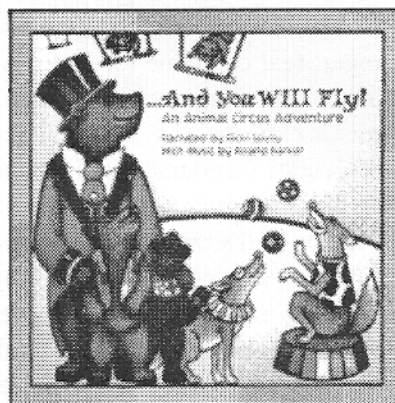
## "...And You Will Fly!" New CD Helping Children

we were Americans, many told us with great care and sincerity how badly they felt for what happened to us in our country.

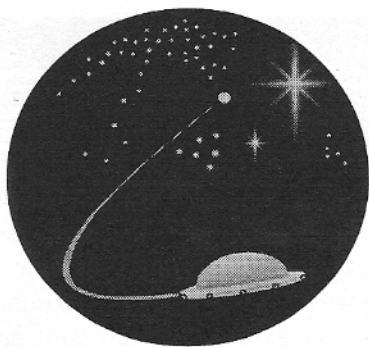
With our hearts burst open, we finally tore ourselves away to bask in the good feelings of the morning and the magic that is so quintessentially Egypt.

I awakened to a very cool morning. Inside our papercrete casita ("little house") it was about 55 degrees. There had been little sun yesterday to heat up the passive solar collectors (our only source of heat in that casita), so it was cool, but I felt very happy and was anxious to run over to the straw bale dining hall and look out upon the Sierra Madre Mountains of Mexico just a few miles south of our dining hall. I knew it was going to be breath-taking to watch the sun come up today.

Yes, I awoke knowing that it was to be a very special day here in the High Desert. We had moisture yesterday-rain, sleet, hail, and it snowed last night!

Certainly there are those who live with that kind of occurrence every winter and certainly don't find it special, but if the recent years norm (as ours has been for several years) is to have no moisture fall (not even obvi-

ous dew!) from October until July, then it's a blessing to have rain, hail, sleet, and snow.

The young fruit, evergreen, and olive trees are singing to finally have a blanket of white over them, promising them more moisture when the sun comes out. 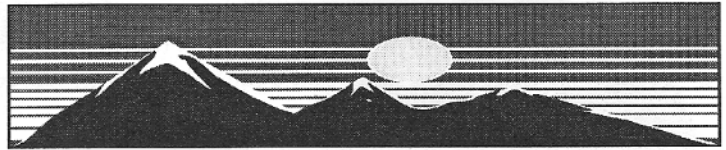
Perhaps we all can join hands, like so many snowflakes tight together and bring peace on earth?

# Meditation and Consciousness

So often we love to hear ourselves talk. Our prayers often revolve around what we desire to tell or ask of Spirit. Rarely, do we ever take the time to listen to God. Meditation, in Asian Psychology, is found to not only be a way of listening to God but also a way to better mental health.

Abhidhamma is relations theory in the broadest sense. Its basic dynamic is then ongoing relationship of mental states to sensory objects. This includes the five main sensory modalities and their precepts, plus thought or cognitive activity, which this systems sees as the "sixth sense". In this system, one's mental health is contingent when the quality of the factors which compose one's mental states from moment to moment. A major perceptual factor is delusion, a perceptual cloudiness or misperception of the object of awareness. False views entails miscategorization and so it becomes the natural consequence of misperception. The key principle in the Abhidhamma program for achieving mental health is the reciprocal inhibition of unhealthy mental factor by healthy ones. Healthy mental states are antagonistic to unhealthy ones thereby inhibiting them. A major healthy factor, insight, understanding or clear perception of an object as it really is, suppresses the fundamental unhealthy factor of delusion. Mental health is the absence of unhealthy factors and presence of healthy factors in the person's mental states.

Meditation is seen as most effective when the mediator voluntarily desists from action or disinvest interest from thoughts which would led to strong affects or which would otherwise distract attention. There are two fundamental strategies for meditation:

concentration and insight. Concentration entails sustained attention directed toward a single object or point of focus. Insight involves the continual maintenance of a specific perceptual-cognitive set toward objects as they spontaneously arise in awareness. As inhibition of unhealthy factors is inculcated, healthy ones are elicited. Mediation entails a simultaneous unlearning of old perceptual cognitive habits and acquisition of new ones. The essential skill in mediation is the ability to hold a specific mental set or a specific object of awareness while inhibiting any contrary perceptions, thoughts, or other intrusions. It embodies characteristics of the Arahāt ideal found in Asian psychology.

The Arahāt is the prototypic saint. It represents the essence of mental health. The Arahāt can be seen as having achieved an alerted state of consciousness, a stable transmuted configuration of psychological structures. The Arahāt is the facilitator of an internal state of calm delight called the flow. The key elements of the flow are:

- >The merging of actions and awareness in sustained, nondistractible concentration on the task at hand.

- >The focusing of the attention on a limited stimulus field excluding intruding stimuli from awarees in a pure involvement devoid of concern with outcome.

- >Self-forgetfulness with heightened awareness of functions and body states related to they involving activity.

- >Adequate skills to meet the environmental demand.

- >Clarity regarding situational cues & appropriate responses.

Flow arises when there is an optimal fit between one's capability and the demands of the moment. The Flow State

is not a give pattern of ongoing arousal rather it is a state of boundlessness. It demands state-flexibility. There are two ways of increasing the likelihood of a flow experience regulating environmental challenges to fit one's skills, as in games or self-regulation of internal capacities to meet a greater variation in external demands.

Mediation's basic skill is attentional focus with the exclusion of distracting stimuli. It is the core of every meditative discipline. Meditation extends the domain of the flow thereby making it an excellent exercise in the renunciation of negative energy and the rejuvenation of Divine essence.

## Children Are The Key To Prevention

After years of a holistic healing ministry, Health Promotions, with adults, my focus led me to prevention with children and family systems.

Much of what we heal as adults is inherited through our genetic code. Unfinished business of the parents is there to be handled by the next generation.

As an example, we may often see a mother who develops her self-love and power. Those skills are immediately transferred to her children.

Healing and growth are an individual's task that contributes to the mass consciousness and planetary transformation.

For interested ministers, I have developed teaching materials to help keep the authentic child intact through my writing, storytelling, and music. *"Self-Esteem Building Through Storytelling"* is a semester program of developmentally based movement, music, and story lessons that validate the self-concept and the inner psychological processes.

It is a whole method of facilitatory teaching that stimulates inner directed learning with critical thinking skills in a non-authoritarian, more humane manner. Children are validated for self-expression and thinking skills while learning self-control.

In conjunction with the Guilford County Task Force to Reduce Family Violence, I have published *Black-eyed Susan, Hope for Children And Families*. In this awareness picture book, piloted in the school system, children learn non-blame, healing, and reconciliation from child abuse and domestic violence. The story gives children key information they might need to

### What is Oigong

Qigong is an ancient Chinese health care system that integrates physical postures, breathing techniques and focused intention. The word Qigong is made up of two Chinese words. Qi is pronounced chee and is usually translated to mean the life force or vital energy that flows through the body and through all things in the universe.

The second word, gong, pronounced gung, means accomplishment or skill that is cultivated through

steady practice. Together, Oigong means cultivating energy. It is a system practiced for health maintenance, healing and increased vitality. Like any other system of health care, Qigong is not a panacea, but it is certainly a highly effective health care practice.

The gentle, rhythmic movements of Qigong reduce stress, build stamina, increase vitality, and enhance the immune system. In addition, it has been determined that Qigong improves cardiovascular, respiratory, circulatory, lymphatic and digestive functions.

There are a wide variety of Qigong practices. It has been estimated that there are probably more than 1000 forms of Qigong and these are usually classified as medical (healing), spiritual, or martial. Everyone can find one or more Qigong forms that can benefit them. Oigong's great appeal is that anyone can benefit from practicing it, regardless of their level of physical fitness, their life circumstances or their age. Anyone can enrich their lives and health by adding Qigong to their daily activities.

## GENETIC ENGINEERING

Greenpeace quotes that Roundup is quite toxic, if sprayed directly on a plant it would kill it but farmers spray again & again on GE soybeans and other crops. None of the GE food grown in the U.S., resistant to Roundup, has undergone long term safety tests. In trials herbicide resistant Soybeans were fed to cows who developed side effects. No further tests were done to explore these changes yet these GE soybeans have been passed by the regulatory authorities as safe for consumption.

Roundup is promoted as an environmentally benign herbicide yet the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service has identified 74 endangered plant species threatened by the use of glyphosate. It can kill fish in concentrations as low as 10 ppm (parts per million), reduces growth of earthworms increasing mortality, killing beneficial fungi aiding plant growth, creating pesticide related illnesses. Highly toxic to humans & animals affecting the nervous system, being water soluble it readily leaches from soil into ground water. It not only affects water & soil but the habitat for wildlife, killing everything. Environmental scientists have found herbicide residues in lettuce, carrots, barley planted a year after soil was sprayed. In addition there is an herbicide drift damaging neighboring crops. Monsanto has received

permission to increase 3 fold its use on crops. Roundup accounts for 17% of their annual sales, expected to increase in the next 5 years to \$56 million, a cash cow.

Complaints from extension agents, scientists & farmers about pesticide drift from GE crops causing destruction is being hidden. Vast damage is occurring by wind carrying pollen, bees, insect and bird flight into neighboring fields as far as 2 miles. Ditches filled with pollen being carried off by animals, equipment, vehicles, shoes. Bird population has decreased by 50%, bees are close to extinction, butterflies are being seriously damaged by eating the pollen of GE crops. What do you suppose it does to humans who ingest this food every day?

Monsanto has put millions into court settlements to growers who faced losses from their GE crop failures, these issues not being reported to the public, as sale of GE seed and products are being hurried into the market without testing. Ecologist magazine reported a number of biotech failures, including GE Canola, forcing Monsanto to withdraw some GE varieties ... only after 60,000 bags of seed were sold across Canada. GE crop failures in 1994 of Flavor Savr tomato, 1996 Monsanto BT cotton, 1996 New Leaf potato, 1997 Roundup Ready cotton are just a few. A legal firm in Texas, acting for 17 growers claims Monsanto misrep-

resented the product. There are results showing GE soybean crops produce lower yields than traditional crops. Many farmers suffered losses being pushed into debt. Monsanto has paid millions to settle quietly.

Contracts with seed companies forbid farmers from saving seed for the next years crop. Bought GE seed costs 3 times as much as regular seed with a patent fee on each bag. Many farmers are not aware of the gravity of the situation when first buying GE seed. Pinkerton detective agency has been hired by Monsanto to check farmers to make sure they are not saving seed. A free phone hotline is setup to encourage farmers to tell on their neighbors for saving seed. By late 1998 475 farmers in the U.S. & Canada had been sued by Monsanto for breaking contracts for saving seed ... broadcasting their names on the radio.

In the first half of 1998 Monsanto spent 8 billion in buying seed industries. Dependence on seed companies is being created by a technique in which GE altered plants are programmed to kill their own seeds ... terminator technology. More than 1.4 billion farmers rely on saved seed. Being forced to buy seed for every planting creates a perpetual cycle of dependence on big seed companies. At present 29 terminator patents are held by Monsanto, Swiss pharmaceutical Novartis, & U.S. public universities. Development of this technology came from public resources serving private interests creating public outrage. Sterile seed pollen can drift from field to field rendering nearby crops sterile.

Seeds treated with antibiotics like tetracycline could threaten the medical use of these antibiotics. The potential for an uncontrollable spread of an antibiotic resistance thru GE crops is a sobering possibility, if not already evi-



dent. We can be left with the possibility of humans finding their ability to be cured of infection by antibiotics decline or disappear as people eat foods with antibiotic resistant genes. In 1999 the Swiss government banned GM maize undergoing field trials on the grounds of studying the safety of antibiotic resistant genes. The transfer of antibiotics thru pigs to the public can happen in just 2 years.

BGH, Bovine Growth Hormone is to trick a cows body into producing more milk than it would otherwise do. This milk is known to be contaminated with pus from udder infections, antibiotics, high levels of insulin - like growth factor IGF-1 which has been linked to human breast and gastrointestinal cancers. Reports by Lancet indicate levels of IGF-1 can increase 70% during pasturization. Cows health issues from BGH are cystic ovaries, uterine disorders, decrease in gestation length & birth weight of calves, increased twinning and retained placenta. In 1999 Canadian gvmnt banned use of BGH & many other countries with concrete health concerns. The U.S. gvmnt approved its use in 1993 to the outrage of farmers & consumers with Monsanto compensating farmers for increased vet bills. The Center for Food Safety & more than 26 organizations filed a petition to reverse the FDA approval of BGH citing Monsanto fraud. Vermont passed a law requiring labels on all dairy with BGH. Monsanto filed a lawsuit against the state of Vermont claiming their rights were being violated.

Results of GE are bizarre. Salmon growth is too big, too fast & turn green. The need for salmon to run upstream is interrupted so animal life, like bears, dependent on this food may starve. Local fish populations are being displaced by GE escapees, outnumbering the locals 5 to 1. Hundreds of odd GE

tomato species are randomly showing up in a foreign country after a tomato trial. Resistant weeds, superbugs withstanding high levels of pesticides are being addressed by biotechnology companies already scrambling to engineer a second generation of crops & sprays. Many GE food crops such as corn & soybeans have already become herbicide resistant.

GE foods do not taste better, provide more nutrition, cost less or look nicer. The instability of GE crops has been documented. And yet squash, and papaya have been cleared for commercial production in the U.S.. Permits are granted for beets, cukes, lettuce, melon, pepper, potato, sunflower, tomato, watermelon.... Our fish have been compromised with genes from chicken, cattle, humans & rats. Transfer of sterile pollen into our wild genetic pool of plants and organic fields & orchards is upon us now. The reality of the world's food being owned by a few giant corporations is close.

Can we allow multinational corporations to experiment with our health & the health of our families? Can we allow all life to become desacralized, reduced to a chemical level, available for manipulation? What about the ethical issues? What about the extinction of species? Who has the right to play God?

If GE food is safe then GE, food makers should have no reason to oppose labeling. Every person has the right to safe & healthful food. Every person has the right to make the choices about what they eat. Every person has the right to know. British law currently requires GM food stuffs be labelled. Eco warriors are burning GE crops in England. Prince Charles will not eat or serve GE foods.

This is barely skimming the surface of

a deadly topic. If this information is important to you let us know ... we can do a sequel. Bibliography available.

Rife with humor and designed to inspire curiosity, Chadwick has peopled the process of Hole Work with a cast of Yuckies, Sillies, Spinners and M & Ms. Chadwick reminds us, "To heal, we need to get to laughter. 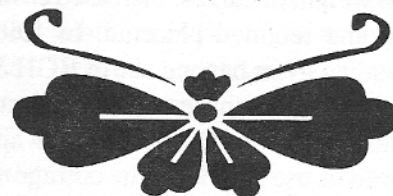

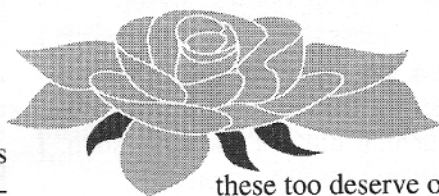
## Winter 2001-2002

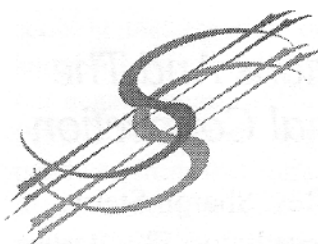

# THE ECONOMICS OF BELIEF

Global economic conditions are a result of our personal, societal, and global beliefs. As co-creators, we are each responsible for financial adversity and we each have the power to change it by transforming our thoughts.

We attract what we think about. When we fear there will be an economic slowdown, we actually cause it by acting from that fear. Money is like electricity, it only works when it flows. When we slow the flow of electricity, a light will dim. When we fear economic downturn, we stop spending, slow the flow of money, and the economy dims. The way out of "hard times" is for people to act from faith in themselves, in each other, and in Spirit and get the money flowing again.

It's this dance with fear and faith that can give us insight into who we have become and how to shift it. I see people as having two faces, like the two sides of a single coin. One side of the "human coin" is our core essence our connection to Spirit, while the other side is our disconnection, created by limiting beliefs formed during childhood. Our core is the light~open, abundant, prosperous, and filled with possibilities. We are One and anything we want is ours. By examining our financial position, we can see into our belief system. If we don't like what we see we can make a conscious decision to shift our "stinking thinking" and re-create our financial world. Here are some powerful questions to ponder:

1. How much money do I earn? Am I worthy of more? Where did that belief come from?
2. How much money do I have? Does that make me happy or sad? Dig deep for the reason.
3. Where do I save money? What beliefs drive my investment choices?
4. What do I spend my money on? Does it get me closer to or help me avoid my dreams?
5. Is \$2 too much or too little for a gallon of gasoline? Wine? How would my parent answer?
6. What is my greatest fear around money? Has this fear killed my spirit or my dreams?

In order to generate a healthy relationship with money, we need to emotionally disconnect from it, see money for

what it really is (Spirit at work), understand how it works and focus on enhancing our personal power. When we release our emotional ties to money, we can start to talk about it in ways that help us recall the power we gave away as children. These honest conversations help my clients recognize their limiting beliefs and open up to greater possibilities. Because I see in them that which they don't see in themselves, they can discover new ways to reconnect with their personal power.

Personal and global financial solutions can never be generated from outside, they must come from inside each of us. Are you living from economic fear or from spiritual strength? Are you stopping the flow of money or stimulating economic recovery? Believe in the human spirit, believe in the free world, believe good will prevail; and believe you have the power to create the life you want. Demand global prosperity and accept nothing less, it is our connection to Spirit.

## Reclaiming Unconditional Love

This is a journey to heal all the parts of the self into unconditional love. One way to view this is through the chakra system. The first three chakras represent the emotional body, the top three represent the mental body; the heart, in the center, represents, to the extent that it is open, spiritual fluidity. The healing process is two-fold:

1. Awaken the divinity within.
2. With the assistance of this inner divine self, cradle & rock the inner traumas that become emotional stuck spaces into unconditional love.

3. To truly access that self-love, we need to create a reality of emotional flow and mental fluidity within ourselves. We begin with the emotional body. There are many tools to help cradle, rock, nurture our traumas into unconditional love (explained in the full booklet). Understand that this process can take a great deal of time: it is a simple process that is far from easy to accomplish, but well worth the effort in the long run. It is definitely not for the faint-hearted!

## Emotions And The Essential Connection

The cure of the past should not be attempted without treatment of the whole, and also no attempt should be made to cure the body without the soul, and therefore if the head and body are to be well you must begin by curing the mind: that is the first thing... For this is the great error of our day in the treatment of the human body, that physicians separate the soul from body."

Plato, Chronicles 156e

The ancient Egyptians practiced a ritual referral to as "cleansing the flesh and the blood." This was to remove the influence of "evil deities", which we would call today psychological therapy or emotional clearing. 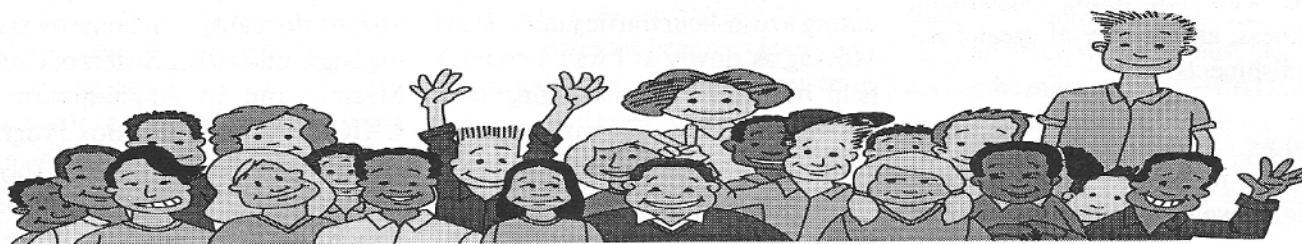

## **MA. Ministers Gathering**

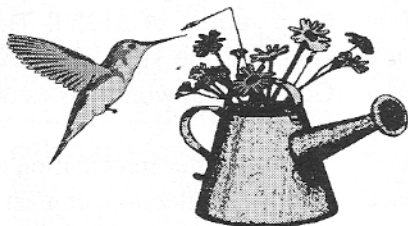
