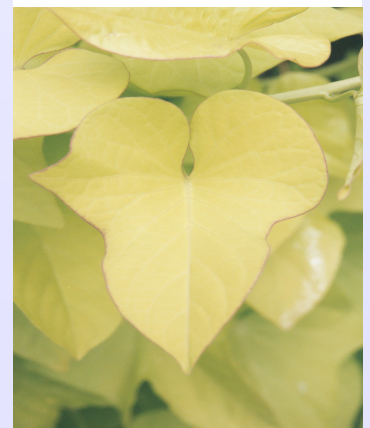
Three new ordinations were the highlight of Sunday morning, where we wholeheartedly welcomed our new Universal Brotherhood Movement, Inc. minis-

VISION STATEMENT
